Gonorrhea

2008 Reported Cases: (481)
42% Decrease from 2007 (827)



Gonorrhea Incidence Gender/Ethnicity Utah 2008

Race/Ethnicity	Male	Female
White	71%	63%
Hispanic	17%	22%
Black	9%	10%
Asian/Pacific Islander	2%	4%
Native American/Alaska Native	1%	1%

Ethnic minorities comprise 18% of Utah's population yet make up 31% of those newly diagnosed with gonorrhea in 2008.

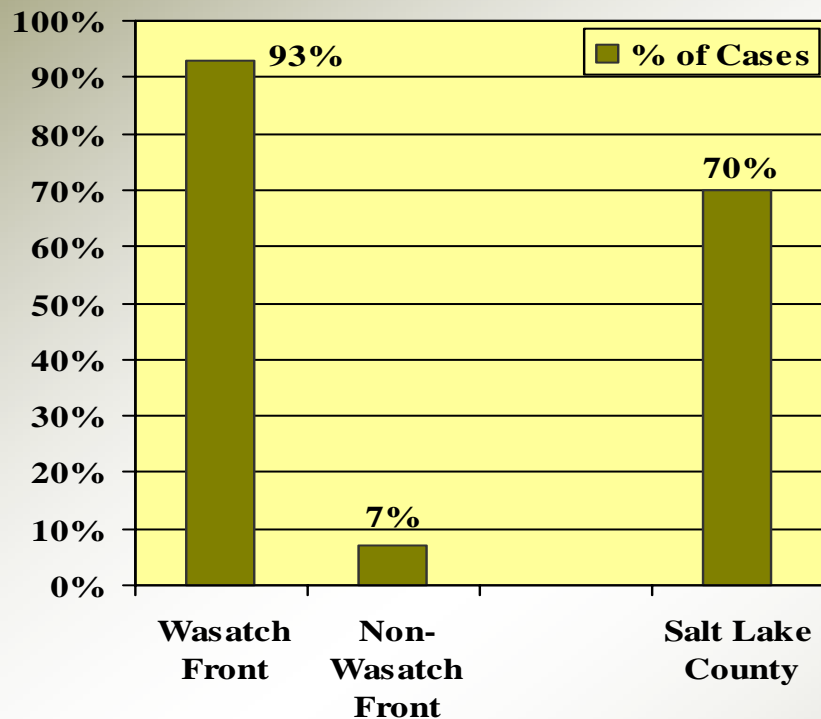


Gonorrhea Incidence Utah 2008

- Of the 481 persons with gonorrhea
- 71% are Male (342)
- 29% are Female (139)

- 15% were age 15-19 (70)
- 31% were age 20-24 (148)
- 21% were age 25-29 (102)
- 32% were age of 30+ (155)

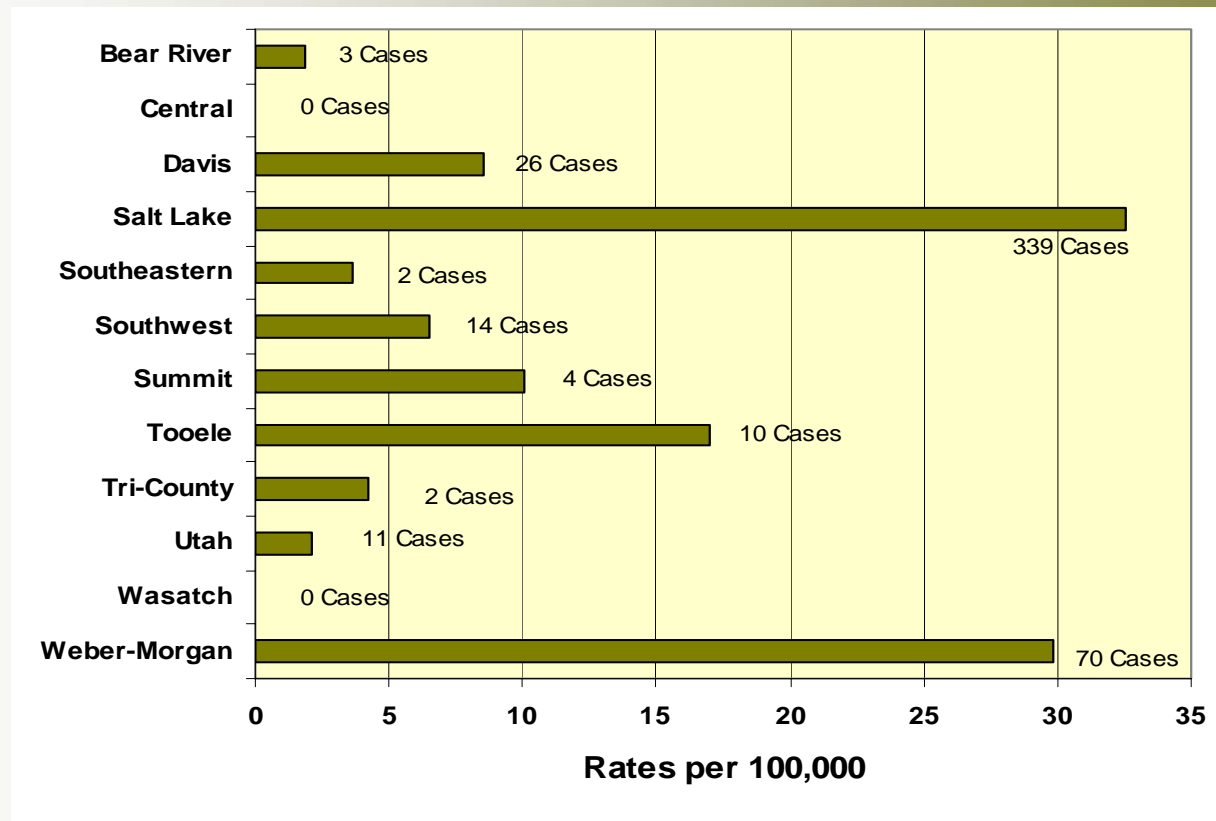
Gonorrhea by Residence at Diagnosis Utah 2008



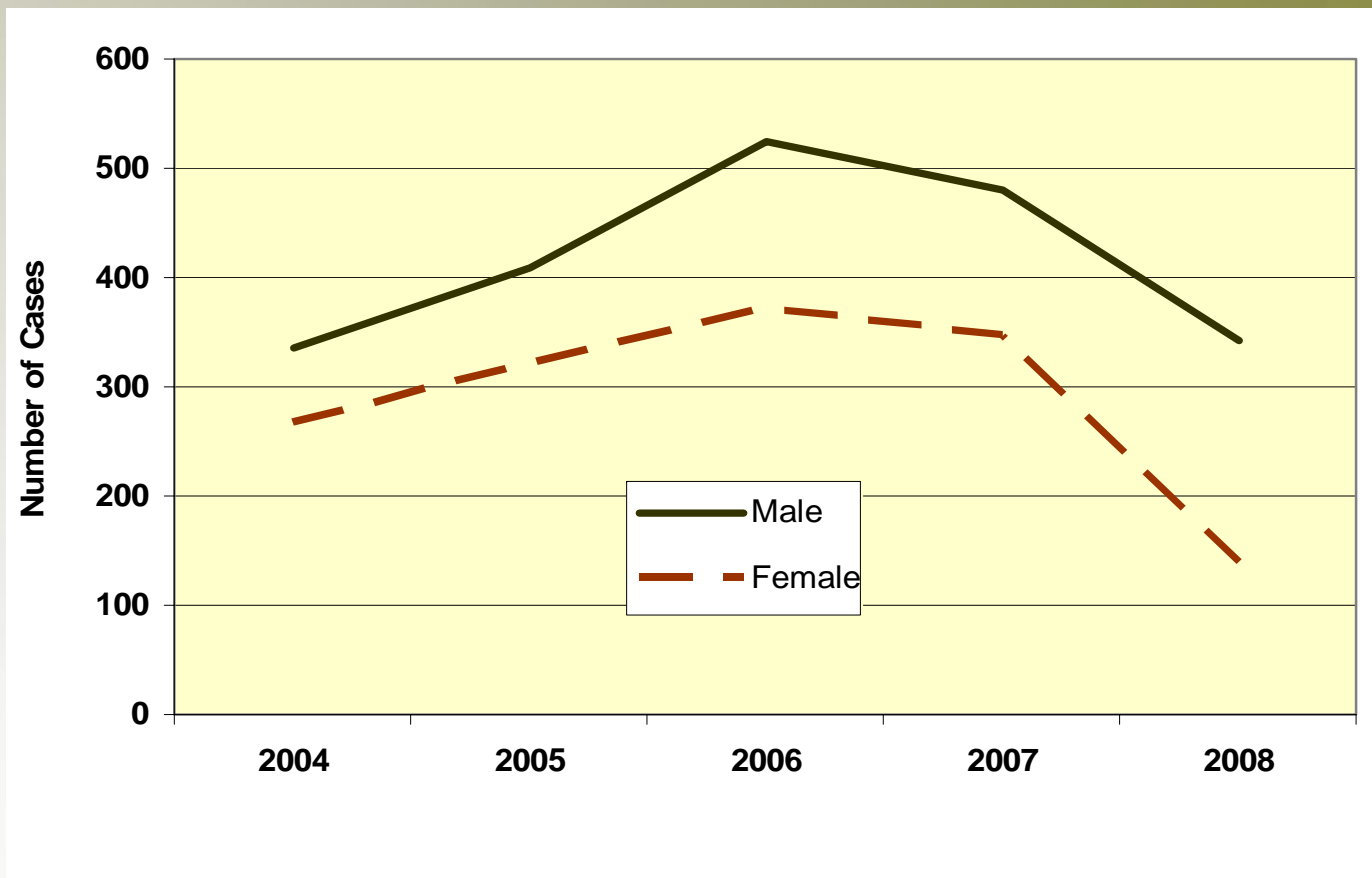
93% of 2008 cases live along the Wasatch Front.

70% of 2008 cases live in Salt Lake County

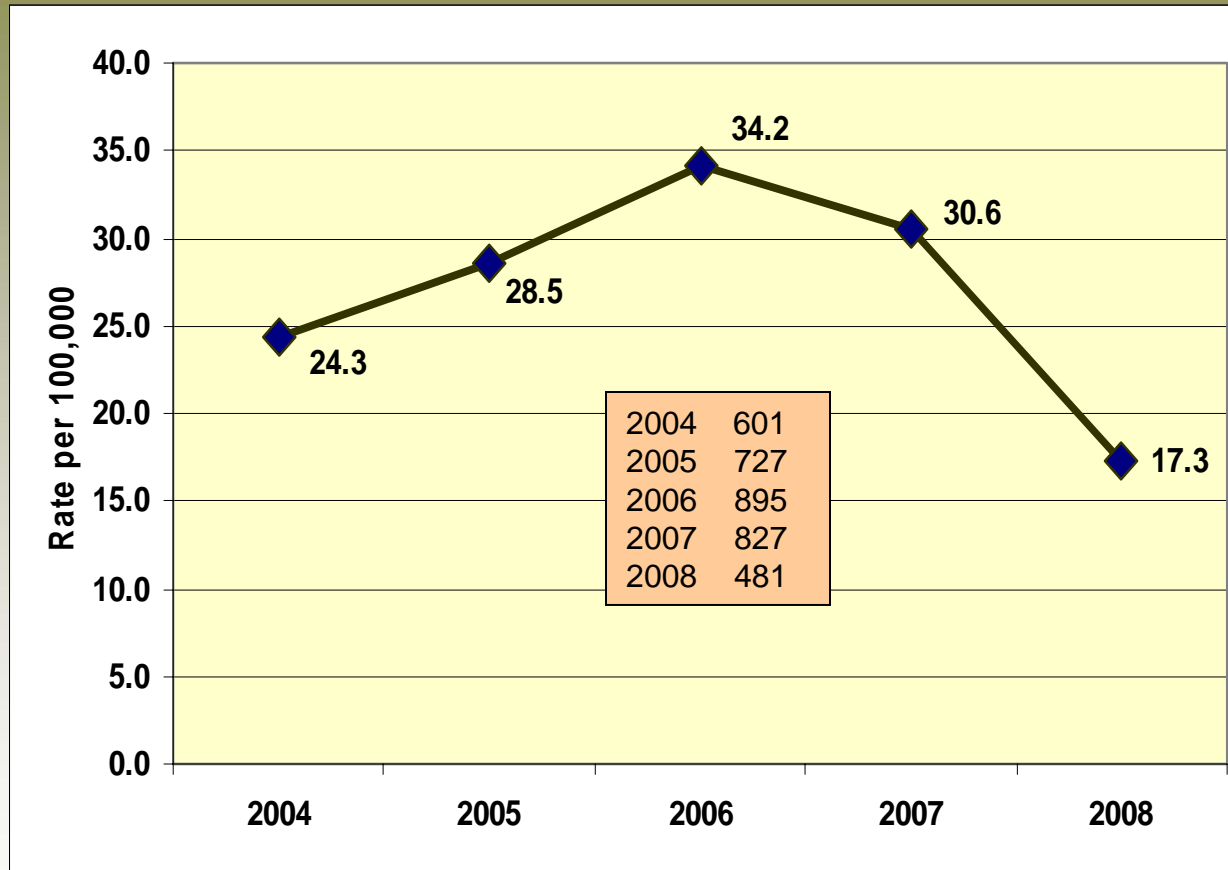
Gonorrhea Rates and Number of Cases by Local Health District Utah 2008
