A statewide multidisciplinary clinical program providing follow-up for very low birth weight newborns from birth to age 2 ½ years.

NEWBORN SCREENING

Fay Keune (801) 584-8256

Provides statewide coordination of care and referral for newborns at risk for one of the 37 (genetic, metabolic, endocrine or hematologic) disorders tested by the state. Services include education for parents, health care providers, and the general public.

SATELLITE CLINICS

Jim Taliaferro (801) 584-8510

Provides multidisciplinary evaluations for children with chronic illnesses or disabilities in 7 rural sites: Moab, Monticello/Blanding, Ogden, Price, Richfield, St. George and Vernal.

SPECIALTY CLINICS

Richard Harward (801) 584-8520

Facilitates access, in collaboration with other agencies, to cleft palate/craniofacial, orthopedic and other specialty clinics.

TECHNOLOGY DEPENDENT WAIVER

Carrie Carter (801) 584-8505

Administers the Travis C. Medicaid Waiver for Technology Dependent Children, including skilled nursing respite care.

TRANSITION

Who Are We?

Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) is a part of the Utah Department of Health.

Doctors and other health care professionals provide services for children with physical or developmental concerns or disabilities at many locations throughout the state.

CSHCN **does not** treat acute illness or injuries and does not take the place of a child's medical provider or Medical Home.

Who is Eligible?

Children and Youth who are:

- Under 18 years of age
- Residents of Utah
- At risk for or may have any physical or developmental concern.

What Do We Offer?

- Diagnostic evaluation
- Screenings
- Multidisciplinary services
- Help in obtaining specialized treatment
- Referral to appropriate community services
- A sliding fee scale for most services for those financially in need.

During a Clinic Visit

Children and youth with any of the following concerns or conditions may be evaluated:

- Hearing and Speech Problems
- Developmental Delays
- Learning/Behavior problems
- Specific Orthopedic defects

Evaluation services may include: pediatrics, audiology, psychology, physical and occupational therapy, speech/language, nutrition, genetics, neurology or orthopedics.

For other conditions not listed above and related questions, please contact us and we will assist you in accessing other options for services.



Who Can Refer?

Anyone can refer a child to Children with Special Health Care Needs. No physician referral is required. All information is kept confidential.

Who Pays for Services?

Families are billed according to their ability to pay. Whenever possible, health insurance is billed. We also assist families with access to Medicaid, CHIP and SSI Programs.

CLINICAL AND SUPPORT SERVICES

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CLINIC

Jim Taliaferro (801) 584-8510

Provides diagnostic evaluations in Salt Lake City for children with developmental delays. Services are designed to provide timely evaluation, follow-up care planning and coordination with the medical home and local agencies.

CHILDREN'S HEARING AND SPEECH SERVICES

Richard Harward (801) 584-8215

Provides statewide hearing screening for children birth to school age and refers infants and children with detected hearing and speech problems to appropriate providers. Provides reconditioned hearing aids to children whose families qualify.

MEDICAL HOME
