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4. Paid claims and ICDCM trauma codes are matched by the MMIS and reported monthly to the TPL Collection Unit. The information is entered in a case file (Social Services TPL Data Base) by the TPL Recovery Unit within sixty days following a match on the report. Follow up is prioritized according to ICDCM codes selected for their history of yielding higher Third Party recoveries. Periodic reviews (6-12 months) are conducted on ICDCM trauma codes as previously reported to assess the potential for recovery on specific codes.
